Math Spiders

1. Cut out spider body out of black construction paper.
2. Cut 8 legs and accordian them (folding). Glue legs to the body of the spider.
3. Each student gets a different number...e.g. 10 and writes this number on the body of the spider.
4. On each of the legs, students write different ways to make 10.
e.g. $9 + 1 = 10$, $8 + 2 = 10$, $13 - 3 = 10$, etc. up to 8 legs.
5. Students decorate their spider.
6. Hang around your room for Halloween decoration!

This lesson can be modified for grades K - 3
